**The Season of Creation:** 1<sup>st</sup> **September-** 4<sup>th</sup> **of October:** The Season of Creation starts on September 1<sup>st</sup>, which is the World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation and ends on October 4<sup>th</sup>, the Feast of St. Francis of Assisi. "Let Justice and Peace Flow" is the theme of this year, inspired by the words of the prophet Amos: "Let justice flow on like a river, righteousness like a never-failing stream" (5:24). Pope Francis urges us to listen to the heartbeat of Creation. We can and must prevent the worst effects of climate change from happening, he writes. The Diocesan Justice and Peace Committee suggests to "green your parish and your home", for example to include Creation Care in prayers; to reduce, re-use, recycle & compost; to plant fruit trees, seeds & bulbs this month and to hold a cycle/walk to church.

A Triduum in preparation for the Feast of St. Padre Pio: will take place at the Franciscan Friary, Rossnowlagh from Wednesday 20th until Saturday 23rd September. There will be mass, Homily and Blessing with his Mitten at 7.30pm each evening. Preacher will be Fr, Pius Mc Laughlin, OFM who met Padre Pio. All are very welcome for these prayerful celebration
